





Border Run 2023

Friday 15th September to Monday 18th September

Bulletin No. 1

This year's Border Run for the Austin 7 Club of SA Inc and the Austin 7 Club Inc (Victoria) will be centred at **Mount** Gambier SA.

This first Bulletin will provide an outline of the programme so members can begin to arrange their calendars. More complete information (including pricing and booking instructions) will be provided in subsequent Bulletins.

While previous Border Run activities have effectively commenced on the Saturday afternoon upon arrival at the selected base town/city, most of the SA club members have historically travelled part way on the Friday, while those who were still on somebody else's payroll travelled the full distance on Saturday.

Some Victorian members have also travelled part way on Friday and may choose to do so again this year.

This year the SA first contingent will travel to **Naracoorte** on Friday 15th September. The option remains for others to travel direct to Mount Gambier on Saturday.

Any Victorians who would like to travel to join us at Naracoorte are most welcome to do so. Google maps indicates that it is only 14km further than the direct trip to Mount Gambier – but it is a long haul from Melbourne in one day in a "7".

As the convoy leaves Naracoorte en-route to Mt Gambier we will have a guided tour of the famous **Naracoorte Caves**, followed by lunch at Penola. As we pass through Nangwarry (32km north of Mt Gambier, or 130km west of Hamilton (via Coleraine and Casterton) we will stop to have a look at the **Nangwarry Forestry & Logging Museum**. The Victorian members can rendezvous with the SA group at Nangwarry at about 2:00pm they wish.

Two nights' Accommodation and Saturday night's dinner in Mt Gambier will be at the **Presidential Accommodation & Suites** which has been renovated since we were there about 6 years ago. Sunday night's dinner will be at the Western Tavern (3 minutes walk from the Presidential)

Sunday's run will be to Port Macdonnell, with the main feature being a visit to **Feast's Classic Car Collection and Memorabilia**, lunch, and an optional visit to **Collectormaniac Antique Store**. It won't be a big driving day – approx. 80km round trip.

Additional details will be provided in Bulletin #2 in a few weeks. No action is required from you yet.

We are looking forward to good numbers from each side of the Border, and a bit warmer weather than our previous June events.

Coorong 4WD Tour

Meet at Meningie Sat October 28th overnighting at Kingston S.E.

Something different for the Austin 7 Club

It is proposed that we meet in time for a 10.00am departure from Meningie meeting in the main street opposite the boat ramp in walking distance to Happy Daise Coffee and Meningie Bakery.

We will be travelling to Kingston via Boothby Rocks (thermos of coffee here if you have one), Messent Conservation Park where we will have a BYO lunch with BBQ available for cooking, from here we have a couple of options which could include Tilley swamp conservation park or JipJip Rocks depending on the time.

All the 4 wheel driving will be easy with Messent being the most challenging with rarely driven dirt track which can be a little bumpy. Ideally you would have reasonable ground clearance and if towing a camper your salt and pepper may end upside down.

Accomodation for Saturday night has been reserved (10 rooms) at Lacepede Bay Motel (0887672444) under the Austin 7 Club, please book early as I am expecting significant numbers.

Tea will be at the Royal Mail Hotel in Kingston at 6.00pm.

Sunday October 29th

At 8.30am after breakfast we will meet in the carpark (vehicles refueled and BYO lunch packed) at the end of Kingston Jetty.On departure we will head out on the Princes Highway. The next turn will be left into Long Beach road and regrouping at Long Beach (this section would be great to include in a vintage car event). From here we will traverse the approximate 9 miles along the beach to the Granites where we regroup in the bitumen carpark (yes David the Prado will be safe here). Please refrain from walking or driving on the Granites as these are considered sacrid by the aboriginal locals.

On leaving the Granites head east on the Granites road and turn left onto the Old Coorong road. We will follow this road until we get to the Cantara Homestead which is normally closed to visitors but we have been given access to view this historic site. We will have lunch here as there are toilet facilities here (a scarcety on this trip so perhaps include a shovel and toilet paper).

After lunch we will proceed to 42 mile crossing and check out the Camp ground and facilities. This is a site popular to 4WD enthusiasts to access the now erroded beach. I suggest we don't attempt to cross over Young Husband Penninsular here as this will involve lowering your tyre pressure to 12 – 15 psi and then pumping them up again.


From here we will travel to the Loop road where we will have a look at the historic 9 mile pipeclay where motorcycles and cars once raced. At one time it was even suggested Malcolm Campbel would attempt a speed record here.

Depending on time there are a couple of other sites we could look at before heading back to Meningie.

Trevor Gent and myself have been talking to vintage car owners about having a vintage car event on regional roads with some perspective participants possibly joining us on this trip.

I feel this event could be oversubscribed so early booking is essential.




Old Adelaide
