

As a follow on from last month's meeting on historic tools. There will be a demonstration on tool sharpening.



1930 Sydney to Melbourne Record

"Herald" BEATS HURRICANE FLOODS AND MUD

Austin Seven's Real Record

While speed records between capital cities are illegal performances, and as such are overdue for suppression, special merit attaches to the latest record—the 12 hours 34 minutes' run from Sydney to Melbourne by an Austin Seven stock racer driven by C. R. Dickason and H. Burkill.

Despite the prevailing hurricane. continuous rain and bad, flooded roads in New South Wales, the tiny car clipped 33 minutes off the previous best record for cars under 2000 c.c., and thus also secures the under \$50, under 1100, under 1500 c.c. records.

The same car, driven by Dickason, won the "A" class and sealed handicap in the 200 miles race at Cowes in March. In May 1930 Cyril Dickason together with his mechanic, Harry Birkill left Sydney at 6 am in an attempt to break the Sydney Melbourne record.

Driving on the Hume Highway, the main road linking Australia's two largest cities.


Back in 1930 the highway was still a dirt road and as the newspaper reports stated 'heavy rail and mud slowed them down', however they established a new record time of 12 hours and 36 minutes.

What is also worth noting it is the same Ulster he used at Phillip Island two months earlier to win both his class and third outright in the 1930 AGP.

Previously, Dickason on 2 January 1930 had broken the record for driving with the gear lever sealed in top gear, by 7h 40m.

On that run he was behind the wheel of a 12 hp Austin.
