
SEVEN. 1930 (prod: 23,826 calendar year). 2-seater, tourer, fixed-head coupé, fabric saloon, saloon. F/R, 747cc (S4SV). The immortal 'baby' with its spit-and-hope lubrication, transverse front spring, rear quarter-elliptics, and uncoupled four-wheel brakes. This type current Sept '29 to June '30, last of the long-scuttle bodies with the vintage look. Differs from a '29 in having chromium plating and ball change for its three-speed 'box. Two-seaters are pointed-tailed.




SEVEN. 1930-32 (prod: 21,282 calendar 1931). 2-seater, tourer, fabric saloon, saloon. F/R, 747cc (\$4 \text{ SV}\$). Wheelbase as for early 1930, but this one (introduced June) has coupled brakes, short-scuttle bodies of more curvaceous shape, and ribbon-type radiator shell. Produced to end of '32 model year alongside the early long-chassis saloons. No fabric saloons after 1931. Saloons have window reveals in a lighter shade of body colour.




SEVEN SWALLOW. 1927-32 (prod: 3500 approx all types). 2-seater sports, 2-seater hardtop coupé, sports saloon. F/R, 747cc (S4 SV). What William Lyons did to the Seven – with pen-nib colour separation (on saloons), scuttle ventilators, round-nose radiators and bulbous tails (two-seaters, coupés). Untuned, always short chassand plated radiator shells, but mechanical changes as for standard cars, ie coil ignition '29, coupled brakes mid '30, centre bar to radiator on '31s and '32s.




**SEVEN ULSTER. 1930-32 (prod: 168). 2-seater sports. F/R, 747cc (\$4 SV).** A real sports car, with 24bhp unblown and 33 with Cozette blower, in which latter guise magnetos and pump circulation are part of the package. 5000rpm sounds frightening, but supercharged ones will top 75. Chassis 3ins lower, springs cord-bound, outside exhaust, and pointed-tail body. Short and long-scuttle versions built, but there've been many replica rebuilds.



SEVEN (LONG). 1932-34 (prod: 63,140 all 7 HP 1932-34). 2-seater, tourer, saloon. F/R, 747cc (S4 SV). 81ins wheelbase, wider track and doors, more knee room and no rear body overhang. Only de luxe saloon models in '32, but rest of the range updated with four speeds (underdrive first!) for '33; this year's cars also have mechanical pumps and rear tanks. Synchromesh and exposed trafficators on 1934 models. New blunt-tail two-seater style.



SEVEN 65/NIPPY. 1933–34/1935–37 (prod: 682 to 1935, inc Speedy). 2-seater sports. F/R, 747cc (\$4 \$V\$). Rounded back two-seater introduced mid '33 with curved front axle, underslung rear springs, and tuned 21bhp engine. All models with low, wide-shell traditional radiator. Some '36s with the more powerful pressure-lubricated Speedy engine, and some late ones with the standard '37 three-bearing unit. Pleasant little fun-car, but likely to have been doctored.




SEVEN SPEEDY. 1934-35 (prod: N/A). 2-seater sports. F/R, 747cc (S4 SV). Made from April 1934, radiator as Nippy (but with stoneguard standard), pointed tail, vee 'screen, bonnet strap, 12-gallon tank, cord-bound springs, and 23bhp engine

with finned sump and pressure-fed crankshaft. Standard axle (5.25:1), but closer ratios. Less than 300 sports Sevens made during this one's currency, therefore very rare indeed.



SEVEN RUBY. 1935-36 (prod: 50,780). 2-seater, tourer, saloon, cabriolet. F/R, 747cc (S4 SV). Lower frame, painted radiator shell, underbonnet filler cap, 17ins instead of 19ins wire wheels, and rearmounted spare in cellulosed cover in all four-seater cars. Commonest Seven model, though overbodied, undergeared, and rusts badly around wheel arches and window frames. Opal 2-seaters of '35 retain old 1934 radiator; new type on '36 model-year cars, from about August 1935.



SEVEN RUBY. 1937-39 (prod: 32,500 approx). 2-seater, tourer, saloon, cabriolet. F/R, 747cc (S4 SV). From August '36, with semi-Girling brakes and 17bhp three-bearing engine, though still largely spit-and-hope. Closed cars have winding rear quarter windows which aren't rust-traps like older Rubies. Full Girling rod-operated brakes from June, 1938. Last cars made March '39. As refined as the Baby ever got, but a saloon weighs nearly 13cwt.


